

OVERVIEW

- ☞ **ALL classes begin with safety! Participants are taught about welding safety, plasma cutting and GMAW (MIG) welding (unless another welding process is specifically called for and noted). Demonstrations and practice time are provided.**
- ☞ We provide a small group setting of usually no more than 10-12 people so that everyone gets the individual instruction they deserve.
- ☞ We provide use of safety gear including welding jackets, gloves and helmets.
- ☞ Classes are **co-ed** unless otherwise specified.
- ☞ **Children** are permitted to register; so far, we have taught as young as 5 years old but only you know how mature your child is. (If you have a mature child under the age of 7, please contact us so we can discuss the possibility of participation.) Children under the age of 14 are asked to register and participate with an adult.
 - **Kids' Day Class:** we ask that a parent/guardian be on the premises for children < 14 years old; parents need not register.
- ☞ **WHAT TO WEAR:** jeans, cotton t-shirt and closed-toe shoes (*boots preferred*; tennis shoes are OK; no sandals); please ensure ankles and feet are completely covered.
- ☞ FYI: if you own safety glasses that fit perfectly, you are welcome to bring them. Otherwise, we provide standard ANSI-approved safety glasses that are yours to keep.
- ☞ Water, tea and light refreshments are provided. (A catered lunch is included for full-day classes.)

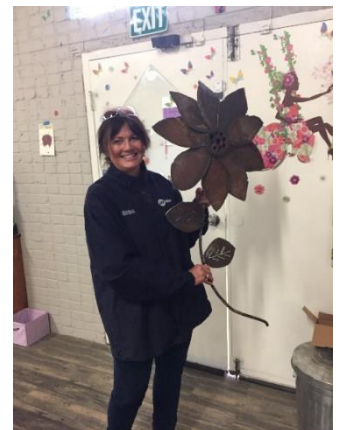

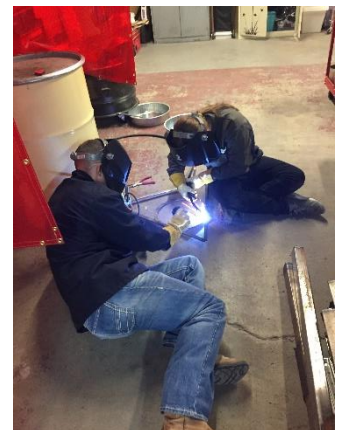

FULL-DAY CLASSES

SNAPSHOT

Participants are taught how to weld a frame out of steel, in order to create something akin to a picture frame. Students are then encouraged to explore various shapes and bits of steel provided in the shop to fill in their frame and create a “snapshot” of where they are in their lives at present. No prior welding or metal cutting experience necessary. (This class is co-ed.)

YARD ART

You’ve seen ‘em. Those giant metal flowers stuck in the ground. The rakes and garden tools transformed into animals. Rough cut sun and moon images hung on the front of houses and sheds. Desert cactus that look almost real enough not to touch. Even dragons coming up out of the earth and tractors stuck in the “mud.” And you’ve always wondered how they do that. You’ve even told yourself you’d like to try that. Well, your time is NOW. (All supplies are included; however, if you have a particular garden tool or other piece of steel/stainless steel you’d like to incorporate into your sculpture, feel free to bring it to class.) While the sky is the limit, please remember: you must be able to transport it home! No prior welding or metal cutting experience necessary. (This class is co-ed.)

HALF-DAY CLASSES

SCUBA TANK BELLS/WIND CHIMES

Create a bell or windchime of your choice made from a repurposed SCUBA or oxygen tank. Makes a beautiful gift... or keep it for yourself! No prior welding or metal cutting experience necessary. (This class is co-ed.)

WEINER DOG ART

You’ve seen them at airports and craft shows... those adorable little dogs made out of springs, sprockets, nuts & bolts. Choosing from a variety of springs and assorted bits, each participant will make their own miniature wiener dog sculpture that fits in the palm of most hands. Guaranteed not to piddle in your living room or get sick in your car on the way home.

This is a co-ed class. Children are permitted to register; so far, we have taught kids as young as 7 years old but only you know how mature your child is. Children under the age of 14 are asked to register with an adult.

LIKE CLOCKWORK

Here's your chance to control time! Let’s make a real, working clock! All clock parts are provided, along with a variety of steel odds & ends to create your very own masterpiece. No prior welding or metal cutting experience necessary. (This class is co-ed.)

HAPPY LITTLE TREES

In honor of the late and great artist, Bob Ross, we will spend this class making happy little trees. The tree you “plant” may grow up to be a wall hanging, a candle holder, a set of holiday

ornaments or some other peaceful nature scene. No prior welding or metal cutting experience necessary. (This class is co-ed.)

SPOON/FORK ART

This co-ed class allows participants to create artwork out of upcycled (a.k.a “retired”) flatware (a.k.a. spoons, forks & butter knives). Two projects will be highlighted (a butterfly & a bird), although free play is allowed. If you have specific utensils you want to work with, feel free to bring them. Otherwise, flatware will be provided. No prior welding or metal cutting experience necessary. (This class is co-ed.)

BUILD-A-JOURNAL

Create your own sheet metal journal, complete with paper ready to record your thoughts & dreams. Participants will use a plasma cutter to create designs in sheet metal to create a front and back cover to their own personal journal/notebook. If desired, other metal designs may be welded onto the cover(s). Paper and binder loops will be provided. No prior welding or metal cutting experience necessary. (This class is co-ed.)

MAKE A SHOWER GIFT

As wedding season approaches, this co-ed class allows participants to create a bridal or baby shower gift that will last a lot longer than those candles, towels, diapers or onesies. Make a picture frame, scrapbook album or other keepsake to give to those with reason to celebrate! No welding experience necessary. Be prepared to have fun! (Unless other arrangements have been made in advance, this class is for women-only.)

HORSESHOE ART CLASSES

HORSHOE ART

Using a combination of welding and metal bending, participants will create a sculpture of their choice. A variety of examples will be provided for ideas; however, each person is encouraged to use their own imagination. Ideas might include: Welcome sign, boot rack, wine rack. hooks for tack and/or other heavy stuff. No prior welding or metal cutting experience necessary. (This class is co-ed.)

YARD BIRD

Make a good luck owl (or other bird) from a horseshoe, washers, nuts & bolts and other assorted metal goodies. Just as in nature, no two birds are ever the same. No prior welding or metal cutting experience necessary. (This class is co-ed.)

KIDS CLASSES

KIDS CLASS: WELD-BY-NUMBER WALL HANGING/HOT PLATE

You remember color-by-number activity books... Well, here’s a similar concept using steel and welding. A variety of designs are available to “draw” on a piece of steel using the GMAW (a.k.a. MIG, or wire welding) process. After ample practice, each kid will create a decorated wall hanging or hot plate to take home.

When you see a unique set of bookends, you usually notice that the form on one side flows into the form on the other side, despite how many books are stacked in between. Rarely do truly interesting bookends exactly match, although they are often able to operate independently. One bookend can stand alone but is stronger and more beautiful with the other half. This flow and function is similar to great relationships. One person supports and enhances the other, despite the distance between.
